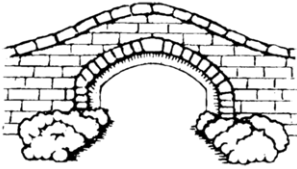

Individuals who complete the program are matched with appropriate job openings in the community. Crossroads Jobs also contacts prospective employers for available job openings. Crossroads Job Counselors explain the advantages which would be afforded them by interviewing individuals who are not routinely hired through the current employment

All are welcome at HealthWorks and have equal access to our health care- regardless of location, culture, age, gender, sexual orientation, or religion. We welcome all insurance, including private, Medicaid and Medicare. A patient whose income is under 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level will qualify for our Sliding Fee Discount Program, which is based on household income and family size.

Loudoun Interfaith Relief, Inc. (LIR) is an independent, 501c (3) nonprofit food pantry located in Leesburg, Virginia whose mission is to feed hungry and food insecure Loudoun residents. 43% of our clients are children. Last fiscal year, LIR distributed 1.3 million pounds of emergency food supplies to almost 17,000 people. We distributed enough food to prepare more than 950,000 healthy and well-balanced meals. LIR's core service is the Emergency Food Distribution Program. We serve our clients by providing households with a three day supply of food sufficient to prepare three well balanced meals for each person in the household. Each household is eligible to receive this service twice a month.

Mobile Hope believes that all children should grow up in a safe environment with all the tools they need to become successful and respected members of our community. Since 2011, we have provided basic necessities and emotional support to children and young adults 24 years of age or younger and to those who are at-risk, precariously housed or homeless in Loudoun County. These services are provided at our facility and on our mobile bus.
